Development of pilot-in-command skills, solo navigation practice, and flight skills to Commercial Pilot standard. Introduction to instrument flight.

Completion of the Commercial Pilot and Advanced Upset Recovery Training phase of the Course

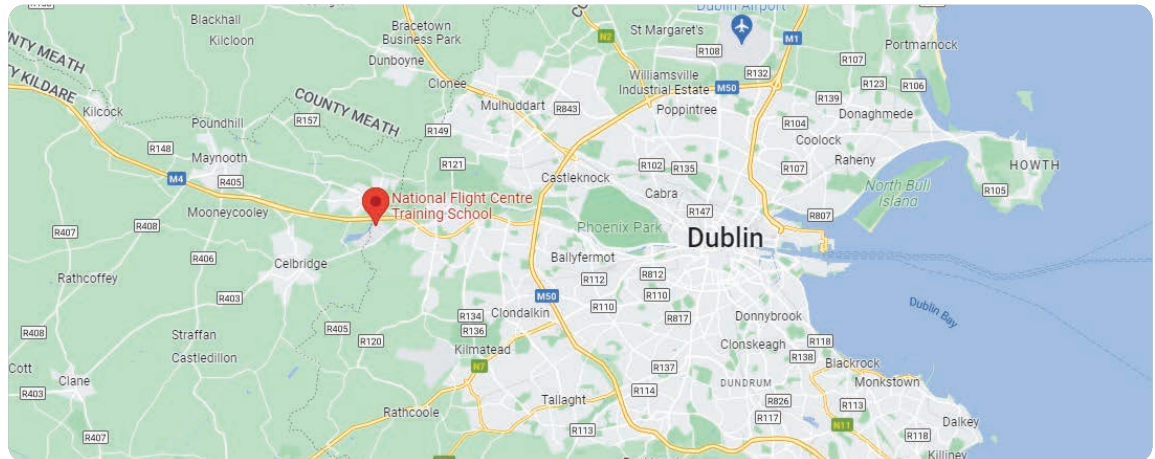


Dublin Weston Airport

Am I eligible
to apply ?

Students must:

- Be 18 years of age when the course commences;
- Have the right to study in the EU - fluent in the English language, level 6.5 IELTS or higher, or equivalent;
- Have Secondary School Education with a minimum requirement of 10+2 science and engineering stream and 70% in mathematics;
- Obtain an EASA Class 1 medical;
- Pass NFC's aviation cadet specific tests and interview.

* Please note certain exemptions to the above may apply

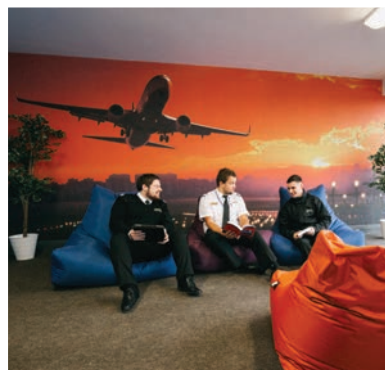
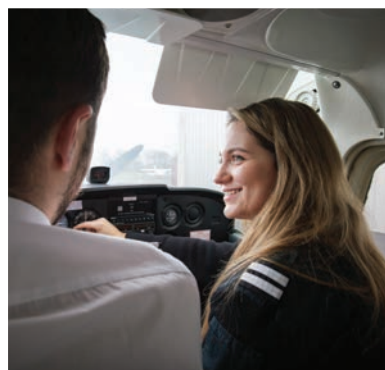


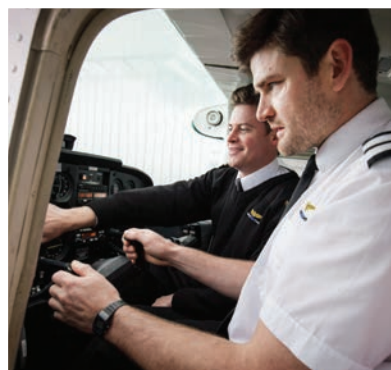
DCU Exclusive Programme

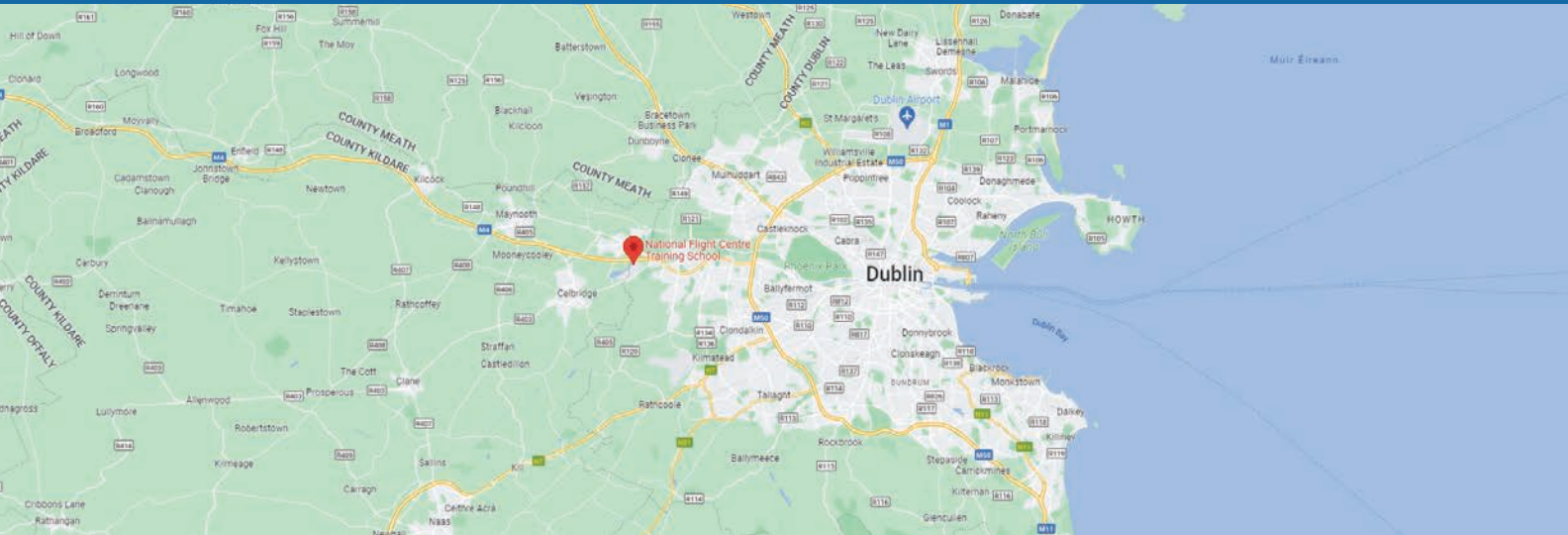
